Course Description

This course is the first level course designed for the novice to learn Mandarin Chinese language. Students improve their Chinese language proficiency in all four areas through interactive methods that help build communication skills in different speech contexts. Students also further their reading and writing skills through various activities and assignments. Each lesson has learning objectives and self-evaluation to give the learner a clear record of tasks completed. Classroom activities have specific learning objectives, activities, or tasks to help fortify learning while having fun.

Learning Objectives

By completing this course, students will:

- Apply learned vocabulary in daily conversations
- Able to construct a short essay using learned sentence pattern
- Interpret most daily conversations between locals
- Able to recognize most Chinese characters

The students' Mandarin Chinese will steadily improve along with the implementation of the program.
